INTRODUCTION

Read article (on back). When have you been motivated by love?

OBSERVATION/INTERPRETATION

Note: Love is the supreme expression of God's personhood and flows out of his inherent goodness. It affects all his other attributes. The Bible does not say, 'God is holiness' or "God is power," but "God is love." I Jn 4:8; 16 Dr. Bill Bright says God's love is the only reason we exist. It is the why of creation, whereas His power is the how. Love demands an object; therefore, we are created as an object of God's love.
