Lesson 12 – God Is Faithful

INTRODUCTION

Read Article God's Word and actions demonstrate *His* faithfulness to us. When have you been impressed by someone keeping their word or commitment? Explain.

EXPLORATION

Note: "Because of the Lord's great love we are not consumed, for His compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great and abundant is Your stability and faithfulness." Lam 3:22,23 "Faith is the confident assurance that what we hope for is going to happen. It is the evidence of things we cannot see." Hebrews 11: 1

Read Genesis 12:1-5 & 17:1-8

- 1. What was God's promise to Abraham? Abraham's response?
- 2. Why do you think it was significant that God repeated His promise to Abraham?
- 3. Did Abraham believe that God would keep His promises? Heb 11:11
- 4. How is God's faithfulness dependent upon our belief and response (or not)? 2 Tim 2:13; Rom 3:3
- 5. Why do we have difficulty trusting God's faithfulness? Numbers 23:19
- 6. How do **1 John 1:9** and **1 Corinthians 1:8** give you hope in being faithful?
- 7. How does 1 Corinthians 10:13 reflect God's faithfulness?
- 8. If exercising faith is like exercising a muscle, what is the status of your faith muscle? How can it get more exercise?

Read 2 Corinthians 9: 8-15

- 9. What insight do you gain from this passage about why God is faithful?
- 10. How does God's faithfulness to you provide a model for your life and relationships?
- 11. The moon does not create light. It only reflects the light of the sun. In terms of our ability to be faithful, how are we like the moon?
- 12. What does James 4:7, 8 tell us about our part?

APPLICATION

- In which area of your life do you believe that God will <u>not</u> be faithful? How will you allow God to help you with that area?
- What can you do to recognize and acknowledge God's faithfulness in our daily lives?
