INTRODUCTION:

• Have you ever traveled where you didn't speak the language? What happened?

OBSERVATION/INTERPRETATION:

Note: Acts 2 is the birth announcement of the church. The disciples are transformed from a group of waiting individuals to a community empowered to act as the body of Christ.

Read Acts 2:1-21; 36-41

- Jesus told them to wait to receive the Holy Spirit. (1:4) What were they expecting? (1:6)
- Why did God wait until Pentecost, a Jewish harvest festival (Dt 16:9-10) to give the Holy Spirit?
- How far had these pilgrims come? (5, 9-11)
- What happened when the Holy Spirit came? (2-4)
- Who made fun of them? (13)
- How does being filled with the Spirit relate to bearing witness to Jesus?
- How does this happen today?
- Can you become a Christian without being filled with the Spirit? Explain.
- If you had been a part of this gathering how would that affect your future ministry?
- When have you experienced an empowering from God to witness about Christ?
- What was the effect of Peter's speech through the power of the Holy Spirit? (41)

APPLICATION:

- When have you experienced an empowering of the Holy Spirit to witness about Christ?
- What are you gong to do to be better prepared for God's Use?
