1	Nile turned to blood	Ex 7:14-25	Nile was extremely important to Egyptians, put pressure on Pharaoh, sorcerers	All the water of Nile, fish died, stank, couldn't drink Nile water	Indifference  (7:22, 23)
2	Frogs	Ex 8:1-15	_____, but magicians could duplicate	Covered the land (all streams, canals, ponds)	(8:15)
3	_____	Ex 8:16-19	Sorcerers couldn't duplicate	All of Egypt	(8:19)
4	_____	Ex 8:20-32	Land "ruined"	Only on Egyptians, God's people fly-less	Deceit (8:28, 32)
5	Livestock _____	Ex 9:1-7	Lifestyle & livelihood	All the horses, donkeys, cattle, sheep, goats of Egyptians died	Hardened  (9:7)
6	_____	Ex 9:8-12	Egyptians couldn't do anything without being reminded	On man & beasts of Egyptians	Hardened  (9:12)
7	_____	Ex 9:13-35	Everything not under cover dies. Flax and barley destroyed but wheat and spelt wasn't ripe yet	All of Egypt except Goshen	Deceit, , refusal to release  (9:28, 34-35)
8	_____	Ex 10:1-20	Everything left growing by hail	All of Egypt	Confession, (10:17, 20) !
9	Darkness	Ex 10:21-27	Darkness that can be felt	All of Egypt except where Israelites lived	, rejection!  (10:24-28)
10	Death of Firstborn	Ex 11; 12:29-42	Killed first born of people and livestock.	All the firstborn of Egypt not covered by blood	"Rise up ... get out... go!  (12:31, 40-42)
