FAITH IN ACTION: #7: SUBMITTING TO GOD PART 1

INTRODUCTION

Do you think God prefers to give without asking or giving in response to a request? Why?

OBSERVATION/INTERPRETATION

Read James 4:1-6

Note: James devotes much space in his letter to what Jewish believers should \underline{do} . He does not neglect to emphasize, however, what they should \underline{be} . Faith must be internalized. It will then naturally affect what we do. Most Christians were poor compared to the rich Jews that oppressed them in the synagogues.

- 1. What is the root of fights and quarrels? (vv 1-2a)
- 2. How have you seen this demonstrated at home? At work?
- 3. What are two reasons we don't have what we want? (vv 2b 3) **Psalm 37:4**
- 4. How can we know if our motives are pure? (v 3)
- 5. What if we ask with a good motive and still don't get what we asked for? How have dealt with this in your own life?
- 6. Why does James call people adulterous? (v 4)

Note: Adultery - spiritually unfaithful to God, having a love affair with other gods. Our relationship with God is like the intimate relationship of husband and wife.

- 7. Why can't we be friends with the world and God at the same time? (v 4) **Matt 6:21, 33** *Note: World value system of those who are separated from God*
- 8. What helps you make the right choice? Col 1:21-23; John 5:39-40
- 9. Why does the Holy Spirit in us "envy"? (v 5)
- 10. Whom does God oppose and favor? Why? (v 6) (humble dependent on and responsive to God) **Prov 3:34; 1 Pet 5:5; Isa 66:2; Matt 5:3; 23:12**

APPLICATION

In what specific area of your life have you been a friend with the world? What do you need to do to change that relationship?
