Lesson #3: Calling People to Believe INTRODUCTION

What makes an event miraculous or supernatural to some and not to others? **OBSERVATION/INTERPRETATION**

Note: this is the beginning of Jesus' public ministry. It seems to bring out his passion for living and endorses human emotion such as the joy of a wedding. The capacity of the filled jars was approximately 150 gallons, enough for 2,400 servings. Weddings typically lasted 3 or more days. Jesus mother Mary was probably a relative of the bride or groom so Jesus was accompanying her and the disciples were "extras". Running out of wine was more than a minor social embarrassment since the family had an obligation to provide a feast of the socially required standard. Notice also that faith led to action, not just intellectual understanding. Read John 2:1-11

1. Where did the wedding take place? Who attended? Vv 1-2

- 2. What is the significance (to his ministry and spiritually) of a wedding as the setting for Jesus first miracle and the beginning of his public ministry?
- 3. What was Mary's request? Vs. 3 Why did she feel she needed to ask Jesus?

Note: It was necessary to have a large amount of water for ceremonial cleansing (hand washing). Water was precious in this desert environment and wine even more so.

- 4. What was Jesus' response? Vs. 4 Was He disrespectful?
- 5. Her response? Vs 5 She implied it was wise to do what Jesus said. What did this say about Mary's faith?
- 6. Do you think she was pushing Him to proclaim who she knew He was? Why or why not?
- 7. What happened to the water? Vs 9
- 8. Why was this a miracle? What does this make Jesus the lord of? What difference does that make?
- 9. Since many people recognized that this was a miracle, did that make them believe Christ was their Lord or just make them believe that He could do miracles?
- 10. What does John say is the reason that Jesus performed this miracle? Vs 11 Joel 3:18, Amos 9:13
- 11. The servants didn't have to understand everything about Jesus, only do what he asked. What effect did this miracle have on them? Vs 11 On the disciples? On you?

APPLICATION

• Many people are motivated by miracles to believe in Jesus. What sign has Jesus given you to help you believe?
