- 5. SoS 1:7b, "For why should I be like the one who veils herself beside the flocks of your companions?" How does Tommy interpret this?
- 6. Why does Tommy say, "If he will not obey God as a single, he will break your heart as a married man?
- 7. Tommy says finding a mate is not a race unto itself. It is something that happens naturally when we run God's race. How does Tommy's illustration (race track) of choosing a spouse differ from the way of the world?
