#### INTRODUCTION

How would you define marriage?

#### **OBSERVATION/INTERPRETATION**

Read Gen 2:18-25; Mk 10:7-9

Note: Marriage is the state in which men and women can live together in sexual relationship with the approval of their social group. Adultery and fornication are sexual relationships that society does not recognize as constituting marriage. This definition is necessary to show that in the OT polygamy is not sexually immoral, since it constitutes a recognized married state; though it is generally shown to be inexpedient (inappropriate). <sup>1</sup>

### APPLICATION

How can your involvement with marriage best honor God?

#### The US Census Bureau gave the following figures:

- In 1920, 1 divorce for every 7 marriages
- In 1940, 1 divorce for every 6 marriages
- In 1960, 1 divorce for every 4 marriages
- In 1972, 1 divorce for every 3 marriages In 1977, 2,176,000 marriage licenses were issued in the United States—and 1,090,000 divorces were granted. A ratio now of 1 to 2!

More frightening, it is estimated that as early as 1990, divorces will outnumber marriages.

#### America's No-Fault Divorce

According to the US News and World Report, the spread of no-fault divorce in the United States is one reason for the huge rise in overall rates in US divorces. Almost 1.1 million marriages were dissolved in the US in 1976—more than double the 1966 total. <sup>2</sup>
