MESSIANIC PSALMS

Psalm 2

INTRODUCTION

Why do you think that some people (nations) are at odds with God?

OBSERVATION/INTERPRETATION

Read Psalm 2

Note: The Lord God is on one side with his anointed (David and the Messiah).

- 1. Why are the nations "conspiring"? Vv 1, 3
- 2. What is the big deal about opposing God? Vv 2, 3, 6, 12
- 3. Why would God see man's rebellion as futile? Vs 4
- 4. Many people do not think that God is actively involved in the affairs of man... He wound up the world and walked away. What shows that God not only has a plan but is actively involved? Vv 6, 8
- 5. Since the Messiah will be all powerful, why won't He be a tyrant? Why won't people be rebelling?
- 6. Who is the psalmist implying will eventually rule the nations (iron scepter)? Vs 9; Rev 12:5
- 7. What do you think would make God angry? Vv 5, 12; Ps 90:7-9
- 8. What does it mean to serve the Lord with fear and rejoice with trembling? Vs 11; Ps 103:11; 34:7-9
- 9. The psalmist implies succession from father to son (& bloodlines). Vv 7; 12. 2 Sam 7:12-16 The king (Son) recognizes God's authority as higher than his own. What would that look like in a Pentagon leader today?

APPLICATION

Are you at odds with God? How can you "kiss the Son?" Vs 12
