# The Sermon on the Mount

**Lesson #5: Personal Relationships (Part 2)** 

# INTRODUCTION

Why do you think that divorce is as common inside the church as it is outside?

# OBSERVATION/INTERPRETATION

# Read Matt 5:31-32

Note: Only the man had the right to divorce and his main restriction was that he had to issue a decree of divorce so she could remarry. A woman who was divorced in those days had little means of supporting herself and needed to remarry.

1. How does Jesus feel about divorce?

Note: Since divorce was legislated but not banned, they thought it could not be a sin. Dt 24:1-4 "The meaning of the word in Deuteronomy 24 includes every kind of improper, shameful, or indecent behavior unbecoming to a woman and embarrassing to her husband. It cannot refer to adultery, because death was the penalty for that, even if it occurred during the engagement period" Lev 20:10

- 2. Why is Jesus coming down harder on the men than the women?
- 3. Since God's original design for marriage did not include it, why is it even being discussed? Matt 19:3-9 Read Matthew 5:33- 37

Note: Any oath sworn is an oath before God and must be kept, for failure to do so is tantamount to denying God's existence, or at best His omnipotence and omniscience.<sup>2</sup> Some Jews swore on their head instead of to God, thinking it was less binding. Jesus points out that God made their head and its unique characteristics.

- 4. What does Jesus expect of a believer? Lev 19:12; Num 30:2
- 5. Why do some Christians qualify their plans with "God willing" or D.V. (Deo Volente the Latin equivalent)? Jas 4:13-16
- 6. Some say that the purpose of a believer's life is to be a witness to the gospel. Matt 5:14-16 How would following these verses about oaths make that a reality?
- 7. Who do you admire as a person who lives by their word?

What challenges you the most about living out these verses of the Sermon on the Mount?
