INTRODUCTION

Why do you think that there is so much lawlessness when electricity goes out in a large city? **EXPLORATION**

Note: Those who heard Paul's first letter may have misunderstood its point. Paul replies that the future "day of the Lord" is coming but the timing is unknown.

Read 2 Thessalonians 2:1-12

- 2. What reaction had Paul's previous letter caused among his readers? v. 2
- 3. What must happen before the day of the Lord comes? v. 3
- 4. Who is the "man of lawlessness?" v. 4; Rev 13:5,6;
- 5. What kind of person will the man of lawlessness be? (v. 4)
- 6. What (who) is delaying the coming of the man of lawlessness? Vv. 6, 7; Dan 10:10-13
- 7. What will happen to allow the man of lawlessness to be revealed? v. 7
- 8. What will happen when the man of lawlessness encounters the Lord Jesus? v. 8
- 9. How will Satan's power be evident during the time of the man of lawlessness? Vv. 9-10
- 10. Why will people perish? Vv. 10-12
- 11. How should a Christian react to any predictions about Christ's return?
- 12. How close do you think we are to the end times and the return of Christ? Why?
- 13. What can a person do to get ready for Christ's return?
- 14. What gives Christians confidence as they face the end times and the forces of the antichrist?
- 15. How can you decide if a miracle or a miracle worker is from God or from Satan? 1 John 4:1-3

APPLICATION

- How can you strengthen your faith today so that you are ready to face any evil days that will come?
- What can you say to a loved one or friend this week that will lovingly draw them away from wickedness and unbelief?

Dr. Rawlings, a devout atheist, "considered all religion "hocus-pocus" and death nothing more than a painless extinction". But something happened in 1977 that brought a dramatic change in the life of Dr. Rawlings! He was resuscitating a man, terrified and screaming. "Each time he regained heartbeat and respiration, the patient screamed, "I am in hell!" He was terrified and pleaded with me to help him. I was scared to death. . . Then I noticed a genuinely alarmed look on his face. He had a terrified look worse than the expression seen in death! This patient had a grotesque grimace expressing sheer horror! His pupils were dilated, and he was perspiring and trembling — he looked as if his hair was "on end." Then still another strange thing happened. He said, "Don't you understand? I am in hell. . . Don't let me go back to hell!" . . . the man was serious, and it finally occurred to me that he was indeed in trouble. He was in a panic like I had never seen before." Dr. Rawlings said, no one, who could have heard his screams and saw the look of terror on his face could doubt for a single minute that he was actually in a place called hell!
